Minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) meeting of Pradhan Manti Awas Yojana, Housing for All (Urban) Mission held on October 27, 2015

The Second Meeting of the Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) Housing for all (Urban) Mission was held with the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation in chair on 27<sup>th</sup> October, 2015 at 3.15 P.M. in Conference Hall, Room No: 120, G-wing, NBO Building, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi. The list of participants is enclosed at Annexure - 1.

- 2. Joint Secretary and Mission Director (HFA) welcomed the Chairperson and other Members of the Committee and briefed the Committee about the issues in the agenda for consideration. Thereafter, the Committee considered the following agenda items:
- 3. Agenda 1: Confirmation of the minutes of the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting of CSMC (HFA) held on 17.09.2015.
- 3.1 The CSMC confirmed the minutes of the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 17.09.2015.
- 4. Agenda 2: Consideration for approval of Central Assistance for the 11 Projects submitted by Government of Chhattisgarh under Affordable Housing in Partnership component of PMAY.
- 4.1 Secretary and Mission Director, State Government of Chhattisgarh provided a brief background on the overall approach adopted in addressing the housing shortage of the State. Commissioner, Chhattisgarh Housing Board, thereafter, furnished a detailed presentation on each of the 11 projects which have been approved by the SLSMC and for which proposals have been submitted for release of Central assistance in accordance with the guidelines of the HFA mission. It was stated that a total of 26792 Dwelling Units (DUs) at a project cost of Rs. 19,0693.28 lakhs has been approved by the competent authority in the state. Out of this, 12670 are for EWS category, 13300 are for LIG category and 822 for MIG/HIG category. The proposal placed before the CSMC is for Central assistance @Rs 1.5 lakh per DU for the 12,670 EWS Flats under the Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) component of the HFA mission, amounting to Rs. 19,005 lakhs. The state representative highlighted the following aspects of the projects:
  - The projects are to be implemented by Chhattisgarh Housing Board on Self-financing pattern, wherein apart from the share of Central Government and State Governments, the beneficiaries would also share part of the project cost.

- The state share is in the form of concessional land for the projects, and in some of the projects State schemes are also being dovetailed.
- The projects would be implemented by the State Housing Board; the Implementing Agency's share in the project is in the form of discount in the supervision Costs.
- State Government has incorporated a quality assurance mechanism in the projects.
- Social infrastructure is already available in respect of all the projects.
- Operation & Maintenance of the projects for first two years will be made by the Implementing agency (Chhattisgarh Housing Board) and thereafter the projects shall be transferred to respective ULBs/Development Authorities. The expenditure on O & M.
   for the first two years has been in-built into the project cost.
- For the allotment of houses, preference shall be given to eligible categories in terms of the scheme guidelines.
- 4.2 It was noted that beneficiaries would require to be identified at the outset along with the break-up of the beneficiaries categorized as SC/ST/General, etc. as required under the mission guidelines. The Committee directed that the list of beneficiaries be finalized and that the beneficiary details be suitably incorporated in the DPR, HFAPoA and AIP that will be finalized by the State Government in accordance with HFA guidelines.
- 4.3 The State representative further indicated that the total cost of EWS flats would range from Rs. 4.21 lakhs to Rs. 8.63 lakhs and the allotment price to the EWS beneficiaries, after factoring the State contribution and Central assistance, would range from Rs. 1.61 lakhs to Rs. 4.61 lakhs, for the 11 projects. The details are given in the Annexure 7B of the individual project proposal.
- 4.4 After deliberations, CSMC approved total Central assistance amounting to Rs. 19005 lakhs [rupees Nineteen thousand and five lakhs] (@Rs. 1.5 lakhs per EWS flat for 12,670 EWS units) for the 11 projects approved by the SLSMC of the State Government of Chhattisgarh and further approved the release of first instalment of 40 % amounting to Rs.7602 lakhs subject to identification of beneficiaries and compliance with other requirements of the mission guidelines. The details are as per Annexure-II. CSMC also decided that scrutiny of the DPRs at the Central level may not be done in respect of the 11 projects, at this stage.

- 6. Agenda Item No: 3. Proposal from IIT Kanpur for development of draft Protocol for testing of structural components and systems for use in projects under Housing For All (Urban)
- 5.1 Professor Sudhir Mishra, IIT, Kanpur, made a presentation on the proposal submitted by the Institute outlining the scope, objectives and expected outcomes from the project. It was also clarified that peer review will be part of the project. It was also confirmed that expenditure on contingencies, travel, etc will be based on actuals.
- 5.2 It was noted that the proposed time-frame is one year. The total estimated cost of the project is Rs. 31,33,920/-. The details are as per **Annexure-III**.
- 5.3 The CSMC, after deliberations:
  - (i) approved the project proposal of IIT Kanpur at a total estimated expenditure amounting to Rs. Rs. 31,33,920/- (rupees thirty one lakhs thirty three thousand nine hundred and twenty only) for development of draft Protocol for testing of structural components and systems for use in projects under Housing For All (Urban). CSMC; and
  - (ii) approved release of 50% of the amount as first instalment amounting to Rs. 15.5 lakhs (rupees fifteen lakhs fifty thousand only).

# Agenda 4: Proposal for approval of methodology for selection of projects submitted under PMAY-HFA (Urban).

The CSMC considered the proposal circulated in the meeting, and decided that the matter needs to be further deliberated upon between the Mission Directorate and the Finance Wing, in the first instance.
