Hon'ble Prime Minister inaugurates All India Mayors' Conference in Varanasi

Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated All India Mayors' Conference on 17th December 2021 in Varanasi via video conference. Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh Shri Yogi Adityanath and Hon'ble Union Minister for Housing & Urban Affairs Shri Hardeep S Puri were also present on the occasion. More than 100 Mayors from across the country attended the event held at Pt. Deendayal Upadhyay Trade Facilitation Centre, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh.

Hon'ble Prime Minister addressing the august gathering said that the Conference will unleash numerous learning opportunities for the Mayors that will help them in enhancing the urban landscape in their respective cities. He also called for evolution in the cities by restoring the old urban landscapes with innovation and technology. Hon'ble Prime Minister also urged to think of ways to improve their cities and contribute towards its betterment. The exhibition held at the event showcased the key achievements of Government of India through various Flagship Urban Missions and initiatives of Govt of Uttar Pradesh in the sphere of urban development.

Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), Government of India, showcased the developments undertaken by each Mission.

The exhibition was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh. Hon'ble Union Minister for Housing & Urban Affairs Shri Hardeep S Puri and Shri Durga Shanker Mishra, the then Secretary, MoHUA, also visited the exhibition along with other dignitaries. Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tripura Shri Biplab Kumar Deb and Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat Shri Bhupendra Patel visited Light House Project sites in Agartala and Rajkot on 22nd December 2021 and 31st December 2021, respectively. The Hon'ble Chief Ministers were apprised by the construction agencies about the progress of respective projects and the efforts being made to speed up the construction activities at the sites.

The project in Agartala comprises of 1,000 houses. Light Gauge Steel Framed (LGSF) System with Pre-engineered Steel

Structural System, a technology from New Zealand which can withstand major earthquake risk has been adopted for construction process.

In Gujarat's Rajkot, 'Monolithic Concrete Construction using Tunnel Formwork', an already established technology in France, has been adopted for construction of 1,144 houses. This technology fast-tracks construction process, is resourceefficient, disaster-resilient and ensures durability. Hon'ble Chief Minister was briefed about progress made so far, by the technology providers and construction agency officials.

Housing Board has identified 336 vacant houses at Sunjwan, Jammu for converting into ARHCs.

ARHCs provide life of comfort & dignity to urban migrants/poor close to their workplaces by giving them access to affordable rental accommodation.

Secretary, MoHUA, chairs 57th Meeting of CSMC under PMAY(U)

Shri Durga Shanker Mishra, the then Secretary, MoHUA, chaired the 57th meeting of Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC) under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) held on 23rd December 2021 in New Delhi. Project proposals for construction of 1.07 lakh houses were approved from Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Puducherry and Uttarakhand under various verticals of PMAY(U). Secretary, MoHUA, also reviewed the progress of implementation of the scheme in other States.

At the CSMC meeting, approval for construction of Demonstration Housing Projects (DHPs) at Dimapur in Nagaland and Kot Bhalwal in Jammu was also accorded. Both the projects will be built using new/alternate technologies under Technology Sub-Mission (TSM) component of PMAY(U). DHPs are model housing projects that showcase field level application of the technology and are also used as a platform to impart on-site orientation, training to practitioners and students in the housing sector.

So far, seven DHPs have been completed and six are being constructed in

different parts of the country.

The upcoming DHP in Dimapur will be used as working women's hostel while the one in Jammu will serve as a sports hostel on rental basis with other infrastructure facilities and provisions. The CSMC also approved a proposal for incubation support under ASHA-India for low cost Bamboo Housing Project submitted by IIT Kharagpur.

On this occasion, a Compendium on Indigenous Innovative Building Materials and Construction Technologies was also released by Secretary, MoHUA. It provides details about 84 technologies showcased during Indian Housing Technology Mela (IHTM) in Lucknow held from 5th to 7th October 2021. It will serve as a useful resource for dissemination of technologies for field level application, replication across the country. The compendium will help policymakers, public/private construction agencies, other stakeholders to select and adopt materials, technologies in future housing projects.

Secretary, MoHUA directed the State/UT officials to expedite construction of houses in their respective areas. He said that grounding should be the first priority of the States/UTs, followed by focus on 100% completion of grounded houses. States/UTs should also declare HFA achieved city by city.

Technograhis internship session at LHP Agartala site

Students from National Institute of Technology (NIT), Agartala, are doing internship at the LHP site to learn about globally innovative construction technologies, their use & how they can be further replicated in Indian context. Large scale participation of Technograhis, including students & other stakeholders, is being encouraged across the LHP locations to create technical awareness.

The project in Agartala comprises of 1,000 flats. 'Light Gauge Steel Framed (LGSF) System with Pre-engineered Steel Structural System', a technology from New Zealand which can withstand major earthquake risk, has been adopted in Agartala for construction process.

Agartala (Tripura), Rajkot (Gujarat), Chennai (Tamil Nadu), Indore (Madhya Pradesh), Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh) and Ranchi (Jharkhand) are the six locations were LHPs are under construction. The technologies were selected through a global challenge process under Global Housing Technology Challenge-India (GHTC-India) in 2019. The foundation stones of LHPs were laid by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 1st January 2021.




