


International Training Programme organised by HUDCO HSMI

JS&MD, HFA reviews progress of PMAY-U in States/UTs





Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, HFA reviewed the status of implementation and progress of projects sanctioned under PMAY-U with the States/UTs on 16th, 17th and 19th January 2023. JS&MD, HFA observed that still there in a large number of non - starter houses which were sanctioned prior to 31st March 2020. States/UTs should, therefore, focus on completion of all sanctioned houses and occupancy of all completed hosues so that projects are closed. States/UTs may submit proposal for curtailment of non-starter houses with due diligence and after due approval of State Level Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (SLSMC).

Till January 2023, out of total sanctioned 122.69 lakh houses, 107.55 lakh houses have been grounded for construction; of which 68.02 lakh houses have been completed and delivered to beneficiaries under PMAY-U.



JS&MD, HFA chairs PMC meeting to review progress of Light House Projects

On 6^{th} January 2023, Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, HFA chaired the 9^{th} meeting of Project Monitoring Committee (PMC) to review the progress of upcoming Light House Projects (LHPs) at Indore, Lucknow, Ranchi and Agartala.

The meeting was attended by respective officials from LHP States and other officials from the Ministry. A presentation regarding the status of ongoing construction activities at the LHP sites was made. Subsequently, state-wise presentations, progress of LHPs was reviewed in detail. Issues related to the ongoing construction activities and allotment process at other LHP sites was also discussed in detail during the meeting. JS&MD directed the respective LHP construction agencies to expedite the construction activities.





RACHNA 2.0 training programme on Innovative Construction Technologies & Thermal Comfort in Affordable Housing









RACHNA - Resilient, Affordable, Comfortable Housing with National Action - was introduced by MoHUA in collaboration with BMTPC and GIZ with the purpose to host 75 training events on innovative construction technologies and thermal comfort for affordable housing to acquaint various stakeholders from the building construction industry with the nuances of thermal comfort. After successfully organising 75 events across India, RACHNA 2.0 has been introduced in December 2022. In over a month's time, more than 30 training programmes have been conducted for stakeholders ranging from students, professionals, government officials, policy makers, builders, construction labourers and others.

The programme will also familiarise participants with design strategies, construction techniques, low-cost solutions, policy documents, building codes, international practices and other aspects relevant to thermal comfort in affordable housing. It also covers topics like thermal comfort study of LHPs and life cycle cost for LHPs along with no cost design solutions to make a building thermally comfortable and reduce carbon footprint. Participants of the training programme will be equipped with advanced knowledge and skillset to ensure provision of thermal comfort in India's affordable housing sector.

PMAY-U: Celebrating Empowerment of Women

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) has been a beacon of hope for social upliftment for lakhs of women across the country, who are now pioneers of women empowerment or Naari Shakti, as we commonly say. Access to a pucca house opens doors of opportunities for families and especially, women of the household. Every day in the Mission, we come across success stories of PMAY-U women beneficiaries who have transformed their dreams into reality – the most important being becoming self-employed. They are Naari Shakti of New India who have paved their own path.





Smt Jamuna Das is a single mother, who lives with her son in Assam's Nagaon district. At the start of the day, she is a cook and by the end, she works as a tailor. She does multiple jobs to run the family and give a respected life to her son who has completed her higher secondary education. She built the house some two years ago with the help of Central Assistance received under PMAY-U and also through her savings over the years.

"Maine bhi apni zindagi ki shuruat ek kutcha makaan se ki thi jiske chalte kaafi musibaton ka saamna karna pada tha. Main nahi chahti thi ki mere bete ko bhi vahi sab jhelna pade jo maine dekha tha. Tabhi jaise mujhe PM Awas Yojana ke baare me pata chala maine turant apply kar diya. Aaj rahat bhari zindagi hai ek pucce chhat ke niche," Smt Das says.

With the house, Smt Das has also been able to start her tailoring job from the comfort of her home which helps in making money. She says, "Ghar me kaam karne me kaafi suvidha hoti hai." Her son is also determined to give her a better life and is able to concentrate on his studies. "Bete ko padhai me koi taqleef nahi hoti ab. Vo chahta hai ki padh likh kar achi Naukri kare aur apni maa ko achi zindagi de sake," she adds

Miss Kunti Singh, 43, is the owner of a beautiful pucca house constructed under PMAY-U in Dhekiajuli, Assam. For her, the house is her "prized possession" – something she dreamt of having right from her childhood. She says, "Mujhe kisi bhi tarike ki dikkat ka saamna nahi karna pada. Pehli list me mera naam aa gaya aur mujhe Sarkar dwara ghar banane ke paise mil gae."

"Bachpan se hi mujhe shaukh tha ki jab bhi mera apna makaan ho, toh sab dekh kar ye bole ki kitna sundar ghar hai. Aaj ye sapna pura ho chuka hai aur aas-paas ke log mujhe mere ghar ke wajah se jante hain," she says explaining how beautifully she has decked up her home with a garden.

Despite several hardships, she has been able to run a tailoring school since 2008 and so far, has almost taught over 1,000 girls who are today earning a livelihood. Miss Singh juggles between her training school and house and is perfectly managing her personal as well as her professional life.


