## **Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh transfers** ₹ 51.52 crore to PMAY-U beneficiaries

On 31st July 2023, Shri Yogi Adityanath, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh, transferred a total of ₹ 51.52 crore online to 5,100 beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) in Gorakhpur. 250 beneficiaries got ₹ 50,000 each towards the first instalment, 2,602 beneficiaries received ₹ 1,50,000 each as second instalment and 2,248 beneficiaries were given ₹ 50,000 each as third instalment. Some beneficiaries also attended the event, wherein they were given keys to their pucca houses.

Shri Ravi Kishan, Hon'ble MP from Gorakhpur, Hon'ble Ministers from State and officials from Uttar Pradesh Government were present during the event.

Under PMAY-U, around 17 lakh houses have been approved in Uttar Pradesh, of which nearly 13 lakh houses have already been completed and delivered to beneficiaries.

On 12<sup>th</sup> July 2023, Shri MK Stalin, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, inaugurated 11 Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) Projects comprising of 3,010 houses under PMAY-U through video conferencing in Chennai. The total cost of the projects is ₹ 358.15 crore. Further, allotment orders and house keys to 902 AHP beneficiaries of PMAY-U were also issued during the event.

Shri TM Anbarasan, Hon'ble Minister for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Department, and senior officials of State Government were present on the occasion.


In Tamil Nadu, about 6.81 lakh houses have been approved under PMAY-U, of which over 5.34 lakh houses have been completed and delivered to beneficiaries.

# Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, HFA at BRICS Urbanisation Forum in South Africa



Shri Kuldip Narayan, Joint Secretary & Mission Director (JS&MD), Housing For All (HFA), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) participated in the BRICS Urbanisation Forum 2023 in Durban, South Africa. The Forum centered around the theme of "Urban Resilience For Sustainable Urban Development". It was held from 26<sup>th</sup> July to 27<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

JS&MD, HFA delivered the keynote address on the theme "Advancing, Strengthening and Building Urban Resilience" along with other dignitaries present from the five-nation BRICS bloc. He shared a presentation before the panel during which he spoke about India's urban journey, key aspects for urban resilience, urban flagship Missions of Government of India such as Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) Mission, Smart Cities Mission, Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) Urban, Urban Transport, Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) and Deendayal



Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), the implementation models of these Schemes and how, over the years, they have been successful in providing ease of living to the people in urban India.

JS&MD, HFA shared another presentation on "Building a Resilient Future: Solutions in Action", during which he spoke about sustainable human settlement and alternative infrastructure approaches.

At the Forum, a wide range of topics like urban resilience, fostering cooperation and finding innovative solutions to the challenges faced by rapidly urbanising regions, climate change, sustainable human settlements, localisation of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), urban water resilience, etc., were discussed in detail by the delegates.

### JS&MD, HFA reviews progress of PMAY-U



Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, HFA reviewed progress of PMAY-U in different States/UTs through meetings held via physical and virtual modes. The meetings were attended by States/UTs Mission Directors and other concerned officials. These review meetings are held every month under the chairmanship of JS&MD, HFA, wherein status of implementation of PMAY-U projects, progress under various verticals, geo-tagging status of houses, financial progress, status of fund releases are discussed in detail.

Currently, the focus of the Mission is on completion of projects and during the meeting, JS&MD shared that the process should be expedited and along with completion, occupancy of completed houses should also be stressed upon. He also added that geotagging drive in States/UTs should be regularly conducted which would help in assessing actual progress and in completion of projects as a whole.

Status of Light House Projects monitored by JS&MD, HFA



On 21<sup>st</sup> July 2023, Shri Kuldip Narayan, JS&MD, HFA, chaired the 16<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Project Monitoring Committee (PMC) to evaluate progress of Light House Projects (LHPs) at Indore (Madhya Pradesh), Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh), Ranchi (Jharkhand) and Agartala (Tripura). Senior officials of the Ministry, officials from the respective State Governments, officials of BMTPC, officials associated with the LHP construction agencies and other concerned stakeholders attended the meeting. JS&MD, HFA was apprised by the progress at each LHP site through a presentation, along with photos and highlights, summing up the work done so far.

JS&MD, HFA emphasised that necessary steps must be taken to complete the four LHP projects within the stipulated time frame and ensure regular and timely supply of materials and manpower.

### House allotment process undertaken in Dhanbad, Jharkhand

Over 40 families were allotted pucca houses at Baramudi Affordable Housing Project in Dhanbad under PMAY-U on 13<sup>th</sup> July 2023. The event was held in the presence of Elected Public Representatives and Dhanbad Municipal Corporation officials. About 150 applications were received out of which 43 were selected through lottery system. These beneficiaries were then issued provisional house allotment letters.





# Cheques distributed to over 100 beneficiaries of Bihar's Aarah for construction of PMAY-U houses





On 26<sup>th</sup> July 2023, Smt Indu Devi, Hon'ble Mayor of Aarah, Bihar, distributed cheques of ₹ 1 I a k h e a c h t o 117 beneficiaries of PMAY-U towards second instalment to construct their pucca houses. Municipal Commissioner, other councillors and senior officials associated with the scheme were present on the occasion.



On 17th July 2023, Shri Pushyamitra Bhargav, Hon'ble Mayor of Indore, visited LHP Indore along with other officials of Indore Municipal Corporation. Shri Bhargav was briefed about the project, the technology used for construction and other relevant information related to the project by officials present on site.

Meanwhile, on 9<sup>th</sup> July 2023, a delegation from Maharashtra Government, headed by Smt Pratima Bhadane, Joint Secretary, Urban Development Department, visited the site to know in detail about the technology, how the project is being implemented and best practices being adopted.





#### LHP Agartala

On 16<sup>th</sup> July 2023, students of NIT, Agartala visited LHP Agartala to explore and understand the prominent construction technologies in use - Light Gauge Steel Frame (LGSF) & Pre-Engineered Building (PEB). The students witnessed first-hand application and benefits of these innovative techniques in construction of affordable housing.



Smt Nargis was residing in a one-room kutcha house with her husband Md. Zameel, a son and a daughter in a joint family set up in Sonbhadra district of Uttar Pradesh. They were facing a lot of problems in the dilapidated house, especially regarding hygiene. Smt Nargis, who was associated with an NGO as a health worker at that time, recalls, "Me and my daughter had to knock the doors of our neighbours to use their washroom. We felt embarrassed, but were helpless." She adds that the one thing their family needed desperately was a permanent shelter that had the basic amenities. But due to their low income, the need could not be taken care of for a long time.

Smt Nargis is the sole earning member of the family. She says, "My job required me to be on field for long hours. Since I had the responsibility of my entire house, I could not afford to leave the job, but I always used to be worried about my children's safety."

There were many things that Smt Nargis had to look after, the primary being her children's future and safety, which she says could only fall into place with a secured house. The family was fortunate enough to come across an advertisement of PMAY-U, wherein they found out that financial assistance is provided by the Government of India to eligible beneficiaries to build a pucca house. In no time, Smt Nargis applied under the Scheme and in 2020, she entered her new home.

"With a pucca house, we experienced new changes in our lives. It brought with itself the confidence in us to work in a better way and live a life of dignity. My children have resumed their studies and most importantly, I have started working from home and in this way, I can also take care of my family," Smt Nargis explains.

With assistance from PMAY-U, she fulfilled her dream of having a pucca house and with the help of other schemes of the Government of India, she was able to start off her entrepreneurial journey. Smt Nargis opened a tailoring shop and the additional income helps her in funding children's education. "I no longer have to seek any sort of help from others. There has been a social upliftment and now the society sees us differently. I am particularly happy for my children, for whom, life has got a new meaning," she shares.



Smt Nargis also gives training for stitching of garments to young girls from her house, about which she says, "This way, these girls are learning some craft which can help them in future employment opportunities. I can also comfortably fulfil my duties since I am working from home."

PMAY-U has laid strong foundation for multifaceted empowerment of women. Access to a pucca house with all basic amenities has an interlinking impact on a woman's life and her family. It gives access to a better quality of life with better health, education facilities and livelihood opportunities.


