Sub: Release of Central Assistance of Rs.8,85,60,000/- to the State Government of Maharashtra as 1st installment (2nd release) of central assistance for 01 AHP project at Solapur, Maharashtra, under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) {PMAY(U)} for the financial year 2020-21 -reg.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the Sanction of the President of India to the release of Rs.8,85,60,000/- (Rupees eight crore eighty-five lakh sixty thousand only) to the State Government of Maharashtra as 1st installment (2nd release) of Central grant for Creation of Capital Assets under Pradhan Mantri Yojana (PMAY) - Housing for All (Urban) Mission under allocation (Other than SC/ST Component) for the FY 2020-21 for construction of 1476 EWS houses in 01 AHP project approved in 9th CSMC meeting held on 26.05.2016 and 24th CSMC dated 24.07.2017 & 43rd CSMC dated 25.02.2019. Details of project are annexed as Annexure.

- 2. Based on decision of CSMCs under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) - Housing for All (HFA) (Urban) Mission and on the recommendations made by MoHUA, the amount of central grant is being released subject to following conditions along with observations of CSMC:
 - State should ensure that data entry in PMAY(U)-MIS portal are completed at the earliest. The said amount is being released on the basis of valid beneficiaries entered in PMAY(U)-MIS. Remaining part of 1st instalment/Subsequent instalment will be released based on valid beneficiaries entered in PMAY(U)-MIS and on other compliances as per PMAY-U guidelines.
 - ii. The agencies responsible for implementation of PMAY(U) should get themselves registered on PFMS portal.
- iii. The funds shall be utilized for the purpose and for the selected categorized beneficiaries only, for which these are sanctioned. Otherwise, these funds will have to be refunded along with interest as per provisions for GFR-2017. No deviation from the framework for implementation of PMAY (U) is permissible.
- iv. State should ensure immediate rollout of EAT in all ULBs.
- State to ensure immediate utilisation of balance funds lying with State/ULBs/IAs. v.
- The expenditure on the implementation of the scheme/projects will be shared between the vi. Central and the State/ULB/Implementing Agency (IA) as committed. The committed State share should also be released within 15 days from the date of receipt of Central Share in the SLNA account. In case of shortfall of State/ULB/IA share, corresponding amount of Central share will be deducted from the subsequent instalment(s).
- The funds including Central and State share will thereafter be released by the vii. State/UT Government to the implementing agencies without any delay failing which the amount would be recovered from the State/UT Government with interest, as applicable, for the period of default.
- viii. Necessary sanctions/approvals/compliances required under the statutory or other regulatory regime as applicable would be obtained by the authority (ies) concerned with the project(s).

- ix. The State Government and implementing agencies shall put in place a monitoring system to ensure that the project (s) achieve scheduled milestone and envisaged outcomes including implementation of reforms and other conditions required under the scheme.
- x. The State Government/implementing agencies shall utilize the grant in accordance with the approved guidelines of PMAY (U) for the implementation of the Scheme.
- xi. The State Government shall furnish Utilization Certificates of the Grant released in the prescribed format as per GFR 2017 to the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs as provided in the scheme guidelines.
- xii. Where there is an element of cash transfer to individual beneficiaries, the same may be made through PFMS/DBT mode as applicable and necessary transaction details may be updated in MIS immediately after the disbursement. The State Government shall submit an authenticated certificate from the bank showing complete details of disbursement of funds to each beneficiary before release of subsequent instalment.
- xiii. The State Government shall ensure the geo-tagging of all houses approved under PMAY(U) and subsequent release by the State Government to the beneficiaries should be made in 3-4 instalments depending on the progress/stage of construction of the house.
- xiv. State Government shall ensure that the specifications of the houses conform to NBC/IS Standards and that requisite infrastructure will be provided by the State Government / ULB.
- xv. State Government shall submit the Action Taken Report (ATR) on the observations/recommendations of Third Party Quality Monitoring Agency (TPQMA) for quality monitoring purpose before release of subsequent instalment.
- xvi. State shall comply with Model Code of Conduct while releasing funds to implementing agencies/beneficiaries.
- 3. The payment may kindly be made to the State Government immediately. The funds may thereafter be released to the implementing agencies without any delay failing which the amounts would be recovered from the State Government with interest for the period of default.
- 4. The amount is debitable from the account of Central Government in the books under the following Head of Account under Demand No.57 of M/o Housing and Urban Affairs for the year 2020-21:

Reference preceding notes.

The proposal involves concurrence of IFD for the release of 1 st installment (2 nd release) of Central assistance amounting to ₹ 885.6 Lakhs for construction of 1476 EWS houses out of 30000 EWS houses in 01 AHP at Solapur in the State of Maharashtra under PMAY (U) Mission approved in 09 state of first installment of central assistance reapproved in 43th CSMC.

- 2. The minutes of CSMC, SLAC and SLSMC may kindly be perused <u>pages 443/cor</u>., <u>pages 796 805/cor</u>. And <u>384</u> respectively. PD has annexed Annexure 7B (for AHP projects) and RERA registration at <u>pp.794 795/c</u> and <u>pp.702 704/c</u> respectively. PD mentions that work order hasn't been forwarded by state but has forwarded agreement between MHADA and Ray Nagar Housing Federation.
- 3. PD states that, 1 st installment (1 st release) of ₹3852 Lakhs for 6420 EWS DUs approved in 43 th CSMC, was released (pp.773 777/c). PD states that As per decision of 43 rd CSMC meeting dated 25.02.2019, funds are to be released in proportion to dwelling units taken up in phased manner and mentions that MHADA vide letter dated 19.03.2021 (pp.778 779/c) has stated that Ray Nagar Housing Federation has grounded the project and so far 7896 dwelling units are under construction and state Government has released ₹7896 Lakhs as state share for 7896 EWS DUs alongwith it placed the request to release 1 st installment of remaining 1476 EWS DUs with total amounting to ₹885.6 lakhs. The details of these beneficiaries is provided on pg 793/c.
- 4. Further, in accordance with the relaxation approved by Secretary, the Division has submitted the following:-
- (i) At least 70% of the fund utilized in projects (or group of projects) where next installment is proposed Subject Proposal is for 1 st installment.
- (ii) At least 80% of UCs received w.r.t Central Assistance released up to 31.03.2019 in the respective State Central Assistance of total ₹ 537.09 crores has been released to the State till FY 2018-19. State Govt. has furnished UCs of ₹ 460.48 crores which is 85.74% utilization of the fund released till F.Y. 2018-19.

In this regard it is stated that as per the Statement of PAO(Sect.), as on 12.03.2021, State Govt. has submitted, UC of ₹ 646.94 crores against the release of ₹ 757.64 crores, which is 85% of UC received.

- (iii) At least 60% of the corresponding State share released State has released 79% of the corresponding State Share (pg 788/c).
- (iv) At least 70% Expenditure against Central Assistance released CA of ₹ 803.55 crores (including EBR) has so far been released to the State. As per DBT report as on 18.02.2021 an amount of ₹ 636.26 Crores has been spent which is 85% of the CA released.
- (v) Minimum 60% of grounding of houses in respect of cases where the first installment has already been released 167% of houses have been grounded so far.
- (vi) Programme Division to ensure that Central Assistance already released has been completely transferred by State to ULBs/IAs State Govt. has released ₹ 743.65332 crores which is 95.24% of the total CA released and PD has annexed letters being sent by them to state to effect the releases at the earliest (pp.781/c). Also PD mentions that MHADA, the State Level Nodal Agency has assured (p.783/c) that unspent central assistance will be released to SIAs by the end of this FY which has been again reiterated. (letter dated 03.03.2021 (pp.784 785/c)]
- 5. In respect of details of grounding and completion of houses during FY 2020-21 along with progressive data relating to grounding and completion against output/outcome targets, PD has stated that so far, 10,07,580 houses had been sanctioned. Out of which, 2,91,288 have been grounded and 45,436 had been completed. PD has also stated that so far CA (1st installment) has been released for 1,65,483 houses, whereas, the State has grounded 2,91,288 houses. PD has also stated that interest earned by state over the past 03 FYs amount to ₹ 101791389.34 (pg 780/c).
- 6. In respect of EAT roll out, it is pertinent to mention here that 370 out of 409 ULBs have been integrated in PFMS till date.
- 7. In view of the above, IFD may concur the release of ₹ 885.60 Lakhs as 1st installment of CA to the State of Maharashtra for construction of 1476 EWS houses under 01 AHP project under PMAY-U Mission, approved in the 09th meeting of CSMC reapproved in 43th CSMC, subject to the approval of the competent authority and availability of funds.

- 8. PD may be advised to expedite the matter with State Government for submission of remaining UCs till 2018-19, release of its matching share by March, 2021 and to ensure timely transfer of entire CA (from GBS and EBR) to the State implementation agency. They may also be advised to take up the matter with the State Govt. for utilization of balance funds lying with ULBs/IAs by 31.03.2021. The State should make an earnest effort to achieve the targets fixed for 2020-21. PD may ensure that the EAT rollout is completed in all ULBs latest by 31.03.2021.
- 9. Further, JS & FA in another file advised file of Jharkhand state registration in PFMS is only the first prerequisite step which has also been clarified many a times in past. PD may therefore get the entire process completed for roll out of EAT module and ensure that EAT module of PFMS is used by all ULB's to make onward payments to vendors/ recipients etc using this module i.e. no cheques or any other mode of payment. PD may ensure that complete roll out of EAT module is got completed latest by end of this month
