- The State will furnish the Expenditure Statement/UC as per GFR 2017 along with the details of Specialists engaged subject to financial norms approved by 1st CSMC as well as adherence to scheme guidelines.
- iv. Further installment of funds will be considered on receipt of expenditure statement/UC from the State Government along with details of specialists engaged subject to financial norms approved by 1st CSMC as well as adherence to scheme guidelines, furnishing clarifications/supporting documents and submission of pending UCs under RAY, if any.
- v. The State Government/Nodal Agency shall strictly monitor the progress of the preparatory work. All bills/ voucher etc. should be safely kept at SLNA level for future audit and other references.
- vi. The amount of Central Assistance approved will form a part of capacity building plan of the State under PMAY(U) mission.
- vii. Transfer of funds to different entities, if any may be made through PFMS, as applicable and where there is an element of cash transfer to individuals, the same may be made through DBT/EAT module of PFMS mode, as applicable.
- 4. The expenditure involved is debitable to the following Head of Account under Demand No. 59 of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs for the year 2021-22 after duly re-appropriation from the respective Non-functional Head to the Functional Head for NE State:
