- vi. Besides this, Air travel to other States, if necessary, with prior approval of competent authority may also be claimed.
- vii. Central Assistance sanctioned under this head will not be used either to buy any fixed assets or to add value to any existing fixed asset, for any purpose.
- viii. The amount of Central Assistance approved will form a part of capacity building plan of the State under PMAY- U Mission.
- ix. Transfer of funds to different entities, if any may be made through PFMS, as applicable and where there is an element of cash transfer to individuals, the same may be made through DBT/EAT module of PFMS mode, as applicable.
