Release of ₹22.8242 lakh to UT Govt. of Puducherry as 1st installment of Central Assistance for SLTC and CLTCs for FY 2022-23 by adjusting unutilized funds released for CLTCs for FY 2021-22 under PMAY-U Mission - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the Competent Authority to release an amount of ₹22,82,420/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakh Eighty Two Thousand Four Hundred and Twenty only) to Union Territory (UT) Govt. of Puducherry as 1st installment of Central Assistance for SLTC with 4 Specialists and 2 CLTCs with 5 Specialists for FY 2022-23, by adjusting unutilized funds of Rs. 12,580/- released for CLTCs for FY 2021-22 under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) Mission. Details are enclosed at Annexure-I to IV and are also as under:

- 2. Earlier, fund of Rs. 24.92772 lakh was released as 2nd installment of Central Assistance for SLTC with 4 Specialists and 2 CLTCs with 6 Specialists for FY 2021-22 under PMAY-U Mission vide sanction letter of even number dated 22.03.2022. UT Govt. of Puducherry has submitted the Utilization Certificate (UC) of ₹24.68246 lakh against the said release.
- 3. The above grant is subject to the following conditions:
 - i. PMAY-U being a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS), the UT Govt. should strictly follow the revised procedure of fund flow as per O.M. No. 1(13) PFMS/FCD/2020 dated 23rd March 2021 issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of

India and subsequent instructions issued in this regard. These instructions have been made effective from 1st July 2021 which inter-alia provides that

- a. The UT Govt. will transfer the Central Assistance to the designated Single Nodal Agency (SNA) within a period of 21 days of its receipt. Corresponding UT share, if any should be released as early as possible and not later than 40 days of release of the Central share. The Central share shall not be diverted to the Personal Deposit (PD) account or any other account by the UT Govt. UT Govt./SNA/ Implementing Agencies (IAs) shall not transfer scheme-related funds to any other bank account, except for actual payments under the scheme.
- b. Central Assistance along with UT share, if any are to be kept by the Nodal Agency in the Single Nodal Account (SNA) opened in a Scheduled Commercial Bank for the purpose and the same is mapped in PFMS. The nodal agency will allocate drawing limits to IAs having zero balance subsidiary accounts duly mapped in PFMS and linked to SNA account for drawal of funds on real time basis from the Single Nodal Account.
- c. The nodal agency shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released, should be mandatorily remitted to respective consolidated funds on pro-rata basis in terms of rule 230(8) of GFR 2017.
- d. SNAs and IAs will mandatorily use the DBT/EAT module of PFMS or integrate their systems with the PFMS to ensure that information on PFMS is updated by each IA at least once every day.
- e. SNA will keep all the funds received in the Single Nodal Account only and shall not divert the same to Fixed Deposits/Flexi-Account/Multi-Option Deposit Account/Corporate Liquid Term Deposit (CLTD) Account etc.
- f. Further releases under the scheme will be made only after transfer of entire Central Assistance released till date along with corresponding UT share, if any in the SNA account.
- ii. The UT will comply with the terms and conditions stipulated in the guidelines, CSMC directions and instructions issued by this Ministry.
- iii. The UT will utilize the sanctioned grant for the purpose for which it is released. The UT Government/Nodal Agency shall furnish physical and financial progress reports every quarter.
- iv. The UT will furnish the Expenditure statement/UC as per GFR 2017 along with the details of Specialists engaged subject to financial norms approved by 1st CSMC as well as adherence to scheme guidelines.
- v. Further installment of funds will be considered on receipt of expenditure statement/UC from the UT Government along with details of specialists engaged subject to financial norms approved by 1st CSMC as well as adherence to scheme guidelines, furnishing clarifications/supporting documents and submission of pending UCs under RAY, if any.
- vi. The UT Government/Nodal Agency shall strictly monitor the progress of the preparatory work. All bills/ voucher etc. should be safely kept at SLNA level for future audit and other references.
- vii. The amount of Central Assistance approved will form a part of capacity building plan of the UT under PMAY-U mission.
- viii. Transfer of funds to different entities, if any may be made through PFMS, as applicable and where there is an element of cash transfer to individuals, the same may be made through DBT/EAT module of PFMS mode, as applicable.
