Anju Rani and her husband **Jagdish** lived in a cramped dilapidated house for 43 years in **Haryana's** Yamunanagar. Their two children were raised in the same house, which did not have sufficient space for the family of four.

"In rainy seasons, water dripped from the roof. In such a situation, enhancing and constructing a bigger permanent house was a necessity. However, due to my low income, I could not fulfil the needs of my family," Anju recalls.

The family's fate changed after they came to know about PMAY(U) Scheme. A total assistance of Rs. 2.50 lakh was received in three instalments. The construction of their pucca home was possible only because of the financial support under PMAY(U) Scheme.

The family now feels safe in their new two-room all-weather house with kitchen and a toilet facility. The home has provided them with better space and gave them access to a dignified life.
