For **Raseed**, a pucca house was of utmost need. He lived a kutcha house with his family and children in Alirajpur, **Madhya Pradesh**. The house was not spacious enough for them and was devoid of a toilet too. Due to lack of a toilet facility, they had to defecate in open, leading to multiple health issues.

“Due to the poor economic condition of the family, we could not build a pucca house. The condition of our kutcha house was not good. We had to face many problems. The children could not even study properly. I always thought of building a home for my family but didn't know how the dream would be fulfilled,” says Raseed.

When he got to know about Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) [PMAY(U)], he applied for financial assistance and soon received a financial grant of Rs 2.5 lakh from the Government. Raseed's house was gradually built.

“Today, we are living in our new pucca house with all due respect. Also, because of the home, people around us look at us with respect. We are all very happy to have a pucca house which has all the facilities. Our life has completely transformed due to the PMAY(U) Scheme,” he concludes.
